#### **Directions**

#### From the North

- 1. Take the Northway south to Exit 6.
- 2. Turn right at end of ramp. This puts you heading west on Rt. 7 toward Schenectady.
- 3. Stay on Rt. 7 for 2-3 miles (4-5 lights).
- 4. Just past the Rt. 7 Diner and the Mobil Station on your left, turn left onto Albany Shaker Road. (If you reach McDonald's, you just missed the turn.)
- 5. The Food Bank is the second driveway on the left. There's a sign out by the road, and the warehouse is set in from the road a bit. If you volunteer on a weeknight or weekend, drive to the rear of the building and use the Volunteer Entrance.

#### From the South

- 1. Take the Thruway north to Exit 24.
- 2. Take the Northway (I-87) north to Exit 6.
- 3. Turn left at end of ramp. This puts you heading west on Rt. 7 toward Schenectady.
- 4. Stay on Rt. 7 for 2-3 miles (4-5 lights).
- 5. Just past the Rt. 7 Diner and the Mobil Station on your left, turn left onto Albany Shaker Road. (If you reach McDonald's, you just missed the turn.)
- 6. The Food Bank is the second driveway on the left. There's a sign out by the road, and the warehouse is set in from the road a bit. If you volunteer on a weeknight or weekend, drive to the rear of the building and use the Volunteer Entrance.

#### What's involved in sorting items?

The Food Bank receives donations of both food and non-food items that need to be sorted before they can be distributed to member agencies. Shifts are generally two hours long and are available weeknights and weekends. People of all ages are welcome.

Three-hour weekday shifts are available for groups of adults (age 18+) in our Salvage Sorting room. Please contact us for details.

#### How physical is the work?

Food sorting and Farm work are more physical than office tasks, but even people with physical limitations can assist in the warehouse if desired. There are plenty of opportunities for people of all ages and abilities. When and where you work depends on your interests and your preferences.

#### What other jobs need to be done?

Office work includes helping with mailings, filing, data entry, and other tasks. Office volunteers usually work during regular business hours.

#### What if my schedule is full?
