



JOB DESCRIPTION

Title of Job:	Child Hunger Corps Member – (stipend position)
Department:	Network Development
Reports to:	Child Hunger Corps Specialist (and local supervisor)
Location:	Multiple
Program Dates	August 2015- August 2017 (two-year commitment)

Objective of Job: Corps member will be responsible for developing a food bank’s capacity and capability to execute program models targeted toward the alleviation of child hunger, with the objective of increasing access to nutritious food in times when children need it most: in the summer, afterschool, on weekends and school vacations, and at home. Corps members will serve a two year placement at a local food bank.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Work with host food bank to develop a needs assessment to identify gaps in child feeding in the local community, and programs to address these gaps.
2. Develop and implement a program(s) that seeks to increase children’s access to nutritious food either in the summer, afterschool, on weekends, and/or at home.
3. Document the process of designing and implementing the program(s) to promote replication and sustainability.
4. Conduct a comprehensive evaluation of the implemented program(s) to assess the successes and make recommendations for program improvement.
5. Build community partnerships that facilitate the development and/or expansion of child hunger programs.
6. Recruit volunteers to assist in the operation of child hunger program(s).
7. Participate in all Feeding America led Child Hunger Corps trainings and other meetings as required.
8. Participate in host food bank orientation and work as part of the host food bank’s team throughout the program.
9. Contribute to Child Hunger Corps blog on a monthly basis.
10. Be an active participant in the Child Hunger Corps community.
